



The Lusaka Clean City Project (LCCP) was launched in the Republic of Zambia in April 2022. It is a technical cooperation project initiated by the Zambian government and implemented in collaboration with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

The project's main objective is to transfer technology to the Lusaka Integrated Solid Waste Management Company (LISWMC). JICA has sent a team of experts, known as the JICA Expert Team (JET), to assist with this. LISWMC and JET are working together as a single team to improve solid waste management in Lusaka City.
